Principle Job Tasks and Duties:

- sweep, scrub, mop and polish floors
- vacuum clean carpets, rugs and draperies
- dust and clean furniture and fittings
- clean wash basins, mirrors, toilets and showers
- clean kitchen counters, dishes, cookware and appliances
- make up beds and change linens as required
- empty and clean trash containers; dispose of trash in a sanitary manner
- wash windows and trimmings
- ensure both outside and inside areas of rental accommodations are tidy and clean
- sort, wash, load and unload laundry
- sort, fold and put away clean laundry
- operate mechanized cleaning equipment
- maintain all cleaning equipment and materials in a safe and sanitary working condition
- work safely and wear personal protective equipment when working with cleaning products
- monitor and report necessary repairs and replacements
- safely operate golf cart to transport cleaning supplies

Knowledge and Experience:

- high school diploma or equivalent preferred
- knowledge of cleaning and sanitation products, techniques and methods, including WHMIS training
- working knowledge of operating cleaning equipment
- physical stamina and mobility including ability to reach, kneel and bend
- ability to lift, push and pull required load (usually about 30lbs)
