We are looking for an enthusiastic, competent and motivated individual to join our team to help provide this environment for our guests.

The primary duties of this position will cover the general maintenance and operation of our park machinery, including tractors, golf carts and other small engine equipment. In this position, you will also work with a team to ensure that all campsites, comfort stations, park grounds and recreation areas are kept clean and well maintained, as well as assist with other park operations, guest services and maintenance requests when required. Some road repairs and site improvements as well as tree trimming are required. This position requires keen attention to detail and flexibility to meet ever-changing demands or requests.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Operation of small machinery to carry out park maintenance duties such as road repairs, campsite improvements, tree trimming, leaf blowing, etc.
- Oversee the ongoing maintenance of small machinery including oil and filter changes.
- Assist with park systems maintenance when required and regularly scheduled duties such as wastewater pump outs.
- Assist with cleaning of washrooms, laundry facilities, campsites, refuse/recycling stations throughout park.
- Ensure park grounds, roads and all public space are clean, safe and well-maintained.
- Assist with general guest services such as wood deliveries, propane filling and maintenance inquires as requested.
- Assist with park projects which may involve light carpentry, other construction and working with machinery.

Required Skills and Competencies:

- Ability to safely operate and maintain mid-size tractors, mini-excavators and other small machinery.
- Keen attention to detail.
- Flexible and able to handle unexpected events with minimal supervision.
- Motivated, trustworthy and responsible; must be able to work independently.
- Responsible for working safely with cleaning products and machinery and ability to follow all health and safety requirements.
- Clean and tidy appearance, professional conduct and strong communication skills are important.
- Physical stamina and ability to safely lift heavy objects, reach, kneel and bend.
- Friendly, cheerful and helpful disposition and ability to effectively work and communicate with team members.

Additional Experience Preferred:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- General knowledge of plumbing, electrical work, carpentry, and operation of woodworking and mechanical equipment beneficial.
- Customer service experience an asset.

Working requirements/conditions:

- This position requires steel-toes boots, park uniform and the use of personal protective equipment.
- Use of cleaning products and safe operation of motorized equipment.

Duration/Wages/Hours: Seasonal- May to end of October. Start date flexible. Hours: 40 hr/wk, shifts flexible. Successful applicant is required to attend June team training date. Starting wage: \$18-\$20 based on experience.
