- Perform daily campsite clean ups including camping cabins and tent rentals
- Ensure grounds, roads and all public and work spaces are clean, safe and well-maintained
- Provide guest services such as wood deliveries, propane filling and maintenance inquires as requested
- Assist with park projects involving light carpentry, other construction and working with machinery
